

Number of Establishments

A total of 593 establishments with total employment of 20 and over were covered in the 2014 Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry. Most of these establishments were engaged in the following industries:

- Non-residential building constructions with 136 (22.9%) establishments;
- Construction of roads and railways with 91 (15.3%) establishments.
- Electrical Installation with 105 (17.7%) establishments;

Employment

Construction Establishment sector generated jobs for 185,572 workers in 2014. Majority of the workers were employed in the following industries:

- Non-residential building constructions with 63,137 (34.0%) workers;
- Construction of roads and railways employed a total of 55,434 (29.9%) workers;





Figure 2. Employed Persons for Construction Establishments with Total Employment of 20 and Over, NCR: 2014 Hundred 700 554 600 500 400 **Employment** (In 300 193 186 143 200 79 100 0 F42100 F43210 F41001 F43309 F41002 All other Industries **Industry Group**

- Electrical Installation with 19,292 (10.4%) workers. (Figure 2 shows the Employment by Industry Group)

Value of Output

Value of output produced by construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over amounted to P245.4 billion in 2014. The following industries generated the highest value of output:

- Non-residential building constructions with value of output amounting to P98.9 billion (40.3 %);
- Construction of roads and railways with P65.1 billion (26.5%);
- Residential (dwelling) building constructions with P23.0 billion (9.4%).

Gross Addition to Fixed Assets

Gross addition to fixed assets of construction establishment with total employment of 20 and over reached P4.9 billion. The following industries recorded the highest gross addition to fixed assets:

- Non-residential building constructions with P2.7 billion (54.5%);
- Construction of roads and railways with P1.7 billion (34.4%);
- Residential (dwelling) building constructions with P0.1 billion (2.8%).


