The Economy of the City of Muntinlupa Records a 4.1 Percent Increase in 2023




Figure 1. Gross Domestic Product of the City of Muntinlupa In Term of Levels (in billion PhP) and Growth Rate (in Percent)

The economy of the City of Muntinlupa grew by 4.1 percent in 2023 from its 2022 level, slower than the 4.8 percent growth in the previous year. This represents an increase in the value of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) from PhP 254.16 billion in 2022 to PhP 264.67 billion in 2023. The GDP levels in 2023 exceeded the pre-pandemic levels by PhP 0.11 billion. (Figure 1)


At Constant 2018 Prices, 2021 to 2023

On the other hand, Transportation and storage, experienced slowest growth rate, declining by 0.1 percent. (Figure 2)
