POPULATION OF BARANGAY MALAYA, QUEZON CITY

(Results based from 2015 Census of Population)

Date of Release: September 29, 2020 Reference No. 2020-SR-073 (POII)

The Census of Population, which is a complete enumeration of households in the country, is designed primarily to take an inventory of the population of all barangays in the Philippines as mandated by RA No. 10625 and Executive Order No. 352. It also collects information about some characteristics of the population such as age, sex, marital status, and highest grade completed.

This special release presents data on the population of Barangay Malaya, Quezon City. Figures are based from the tabulated data of the 2015 Census of Population.

Total Population of Barangay Malaya Reaches 4,109

The total population of Barangay Malaya, Quezon City reached 4,109 as of August 1, 2015. This accounts for 0.1 percent of the city's total population. The household population of Barangay Malaya constituted a sum of 4,097 while the remaining 12 people belonged


to the institutional population or those residing in institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages, homes for the aged, jails, and military camps.

Of the household population, 1,974 or 48.2 percent were male while 2,123 or 51.8 percent were female. These figures resulted to a sex ratio of 93 males per 100 females.

Persons Aged 20 to 24 Years Comprise the Largest Age Group

The age-sex distribution of the population showed that persons aged 20 to 24 years comprised the largest age group, making up 10.9 percent of the household population. This was followed by those in the age groups 25 to 29 years (10.4 percent) and 15 to 19 years (9.7 percent).

Males outnumbered females in the age groups 0 to 54 years and in the older age groups, 55 years old and over. *Refer to Table 2 for details.*

Median Age is 28 Years

In 2015, the median age of the household population of Barangay Malaya was 28. This means that half of the household population was younger than 28 years. This was higher than the median age of Quezon City which was 26 years.

Five in Seven of the Household Population are of Voting Age


A total of 2,910 or 71.0 percent of the barangay's household populace belonged to the voting population or those aged 18 years and over. There were more female voters (1,561 or 53.6 percent) than male voters (1,349 or 46.4 percent). Refer to Table 3 for details.

Senior Citizens Constitute 7.5 Percent of the Household Population

People who were regarded as senior citizens were those aged 60 years and over. In 2015, senior citizens made up 7.5 percent of the barangay's household population. Among the senior citizens, females (59.7 percent) outnumbered males (40.3 percent). *Refer to Table 2 for details.*

Overall Dependency Ratio Totals 39 Dependents

The overall dependency ratio of Barangay Malaya was 39, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population, there were about 39 dependents (32 young dependents and 7 old dependents). This was lower than the overall dependency ratio of Quezon City which was 44 dependents. *Refer to Table 4 for details.*





One Elderly for Every Three Children Below 15 Years

The ageing index or the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years in Barangay Malaya registered 32.2 percent. This translates to one persons aged 60 years and over for every three children under 15 years old.

Never Been Married Persons Tally 51.6 Percent

Of the total household population 10 years old and over, 51.6 percent has never been married while 32.5 percent was married. The rest of the population was categorized as follows: common-law/live-in (8.6 percent), widowed (4.2 percent), divorced (2.8 percent) and unknown (0.3 percent). Among those who have never been married, a higher proportion in females (51.5 percent) than in males (48.5 percent) was recorded. Likewise, the proportion of females was higher than males among those who were widowed (83.6 percent), divorced/separated (63.3 percent), married (51.5 percent) and common-law/live-in (50.3 percent), while there was equal proportion of males and females with unknown marital status. *Refer to Table 5 for details*.

Females Outnumber Males Among Baccalaureate Degree Holders

Of the total household population 5 years old and over, 31.7 percent had attended or completed high school education, 25.1 percent were baccalaureate degree holders, 20.0 percent were college undergraduates and 15.3 percent had attended or completed elementary school education. Among those baccalaureate degree holders, there were more females (55.2 percent) than males (44.8 percent). *Refer to Table 6 for details*.

Simple Literacy Rate is Recorded at 97.9 Percent

Barangay Malaya recorded a literacy rate of 97.9 percent which was slightly lower than the total literacy rate of Quezon City that was at 98.3 percent. Literacy rate was higher among females (98.1 percent) than males (97.7 percent). *Refer to Table 7 for details*.

Five in Every Eight Persons are Engaged in a Gainful Activity

Approximately five in every eight persons (62.9 percent) were engaged in gainful activity during the 12 months preceding the census. Among the major occupation groups, service and sales workers comprised the largest group (20.6 percent). Clerical support workers came next (17.8 percent), followed by professionals (14.0 percent). *Refer to Table 8 for details*.
