POPULATION OF BARANGAY SANTOL, QUEZON CITY

(Results based from 2015 Census of Population)

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The Census of Population, which is a complete enumeration of households in the country, is designed primarily to take an inventory of the population of all barangays in the Philippines as mandated by RA No. 10625 and Executive Order No. 352. It also collects information about some characteristics of the population such as age, sex, marital status, and highest grade completed.

This special release presents data on the population of Barangay Santol, Quezon City. Figures are based from the tabulated data of the 2015 Census of Population.

Total Population of Barangay Santol Reaches 7,548

The total population of Barangay Santol, Quezon City reached 7,548 as of August 1, 2015. This accounts for 0.3 percent of the city's total population. Total The household population of Barangay Santol constituted a sum of 7,534 while the remaining 14 people belonged to


the institutional population or those residing in institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages, homes for the aged, jails, and military camps.

Of the household population, 3,676 or 48.8 percent were male while 3,858 or 51.2 percent were female. These figures resulted to a sex ratio of 95 males per 100 females.

Persons Aged 20 to 24 Years Comprise the Largest Age Group

The age-sex distribution of the population showed that persons aged 20 to 24 years comprised the largest age group, making up 10.9 percent of the household population. This was followed by those in the age groups 15 to 19 years (10.5 percent) and 25 to 29 years (10.3 percent).

Females outnumbered males in the age groups 0 to 54 years and in the older age groups, 55 years old and over. *Refer to Table 2 for details.*



Median Age is 27 Years

In 2015, the median age of the household population of Barangay Santol was 27. This means that half of the household population was younger than 27 years. This was higher than the median age of Quezon City which was 26 years.

Five in Seven of the Household Population are of Voting Age


A total of 5,297 or 70.3 percent of the barangay's household populace belonged to the voting population or those aged 18 years and over. There were more female voters (2,809 or 53.0 percent) than male voters (2,488 or 47 percent). *Refer to Table 3 for details*.

Senior Citizens Constitute 7.8 Percent of the Household Population

People who were regarded as senior citizens were those aged 60 years and over. In 2015, senior citizens made up 7.8 percent of the barangay's household population. Among the senior citizens, females (57.2 percent) outnumbered males (42.8 percent). Refer to Table 2 for details.

Overall Dependency Ratio Totals 40 Dependents

The overall dependency ratio of Barangay Santol was 40, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population, there were about 40 dependents (33 young dependents and 7 old dependents). This was lower than the overall dependency ratio of Quezon City which was 44 dependents. *Refer to Table 4 for details*.




One Elderly for Every Three Children Below 15 Years

The ageing index or the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years in Barangay Santol registered 33.0 percent. This translates to one persons aged 60 years and over for every three children under 15 years old.

Never Been Married Persons Tally 51.3 Percent

Of the total household population 10 years old and over, 51.3 percent has never been married while 36.7 percent was married. The rest of the population was categorized common-law/live-in (5.9)percent), widowed divorced/separated (2.5 percent) and unknown (0.1 percent). Among those who have never been married, a higher proportion in females (50.8 percent) than in males (49.2 percent) was recorded. Likewise, the proportion of females was higher than males among those who were widowed (80.2 percent), divorced/separated (65.4 percent), common-law/live-in (52.9 percent), married (50.7 percent) and unknown (60.0 percent). Females Outnumber Males Among Baccalaureate Degree Holders

Of the total household population 5 years old and over, 32.5 percent had attended or completed high school education, 27.0 percent were baccalaureate degree holders, 18.4 percent were college undergraduates and 15.2 percent had attended or completed elementary school education. Among those baccalaureate degree holders, there were more females (53.9 percent) than males (46.1 percent). *Refer to Table 6 for details*.

Simple Literacy Rate is Recorded at 98.0 Percent

Barangay Santol recorded a literacy rate of 98.0 percent which was slightly lower than the total literacy rate of Quezon City that was at 98.3 percent. Literacy rate was higher among males (98.1 percent) than females (97.8 percent). *Refer to Table 7 for details.*

Three in Every Five Persons Are Engaged in a Gainful Activity

Approximately three in every five persons (59.6 percent) were engaged in gainful activity during the 12 months preceding the census. Among the major occupation groups, clerical support workers comprised the largest group (19.9 percent). Service and sales workers came next (16.2 percent), followed by workers engaged in elementary occupations (12.4 percent). *Refer to Table 8 for details*.

TECHNICAL NOTES

The 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015) was undertaken by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) in August 2015 as mandated by Republic Act No. 10625, otherwise known as the Philippine Statistics Act of 2013. It was the 14th census of population that was undertaken since the first census in 1903. POPCEN 2015 was designed to take an inventory of the total population all over the Philippines and collect information about their characteristics. Census day for the POPCEN 2015 was August 1, 2015 (12:01 a.m.). POPCEN 2015 made use of the de jure concept of enumeration wherein households and persons are enumerated in the area where they usually reside as of the census reference date. Enumeration lasted for about 25 days, from 10 August to 6 September 2015. Enumeration was extended until 15 September 2015 for large provinces and some highly urbanized cities.
