The training aimed to equip Registration Kit Operators (RKO) and Registration Assistants (RA) with the skills to effectively validate the authenticity of documents and IDs presented during National ID registration and/or updating.

The training was strategically divided into three days to ensure that all 28 RKO and RA could participate without disrupting the daily registration process. This setup allowed continuous operations while guaranteeing that every staff member could gain valuable knowledge and hands-on experience.
