Mrs. Crisostomo, a widow and mother of outgoing Makati City Councilor Hon. Carmina Ortega, personally completed her registration in City of Makati—demonstrating that age is never a barrier to participating in essential government programs. Her registration supports her application for late birth registration and access to services for senior citizens as she approaches her 100th birthday.

Mrs. Crisostomo's participation underscores the importance of the National ID System in providing a single, secure, and universally accepted proof of identity for all Filipinos, especially the elderly.
