

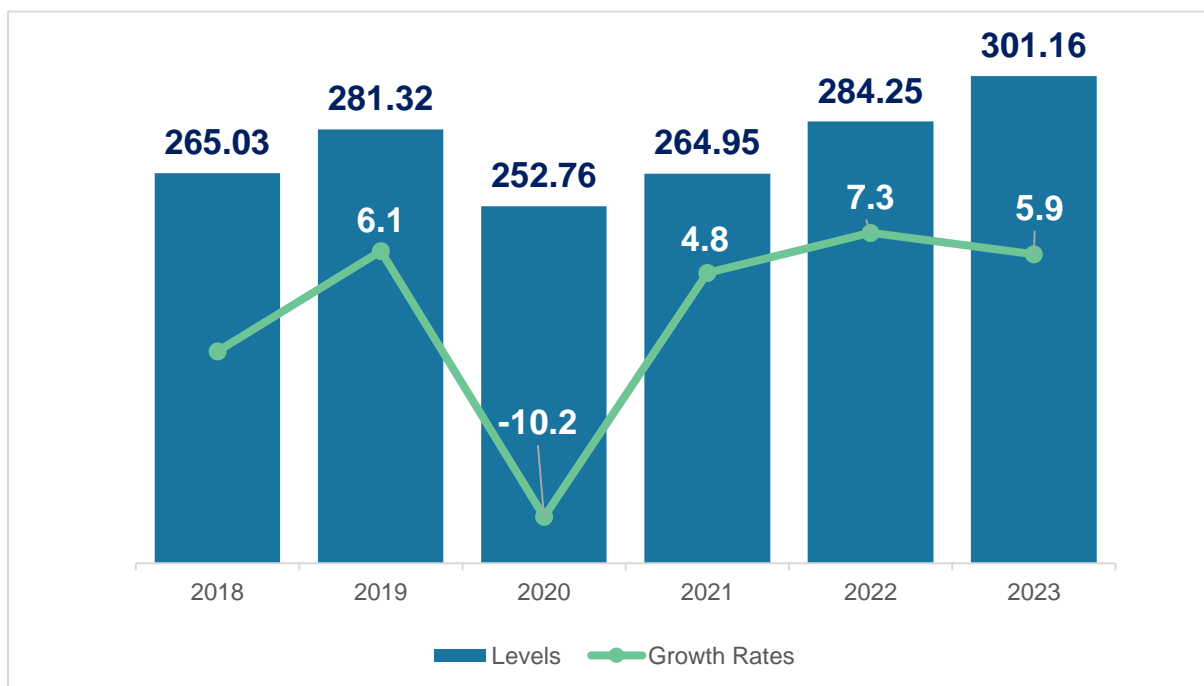

City of Mandaluyong’s Economy Increased by 5.9 Percent in 2023

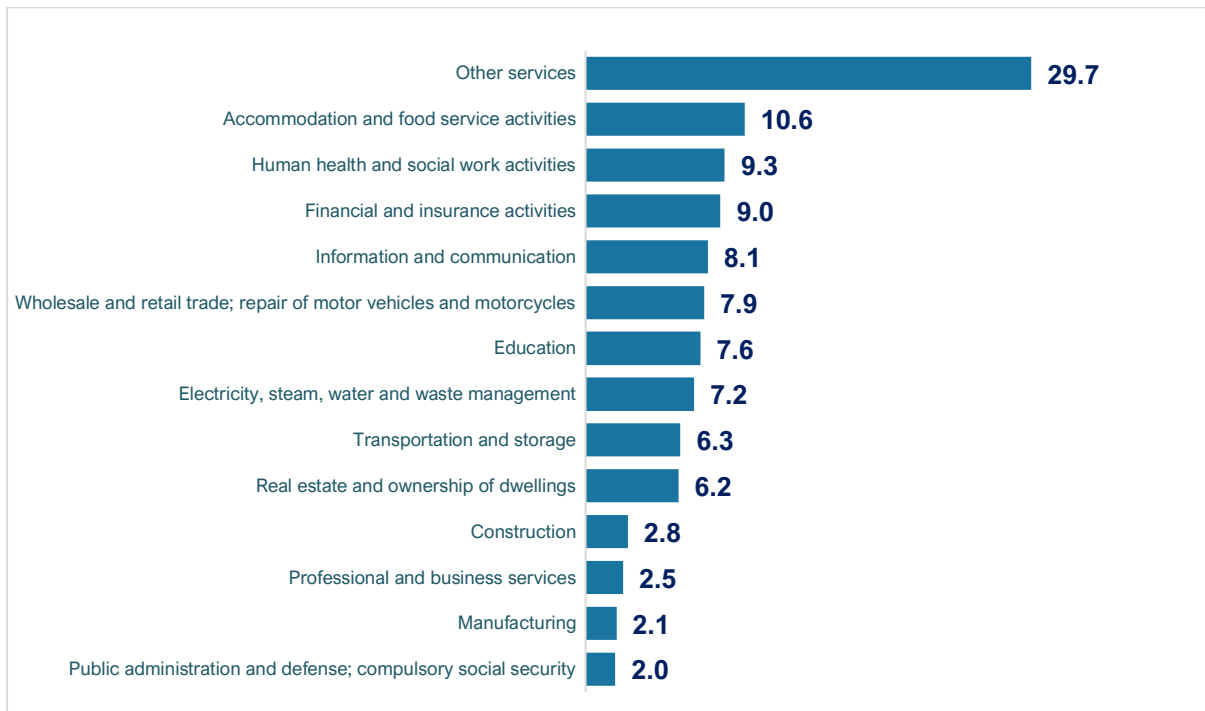
Figure 1. Gross Domestic Product of City of Mandaluyong

The economy of City of Mandaluyong grew by 5.9 percent in 2023 from its 2022 level. This was slower than the 7.3 percent growth experienced in the previous year. The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of City of Mandaluyong was estimated at PhP 301.16 billion, which is PhP 36.13 billion higher than pre-pandemic level of 2018. (Figure 1)

Among the industries, the fastest growths were observed in Other services with 29.7 percent, followed by Accommodation and food service activities with 10.6 percent, and Human health and social work activities with 9.3 percent. Moreover, all the other industries in the city posted significant growth rates. (Figure 2)

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) established through Republic Act No. 10625, otherwise known as the Philippine Statistical Act of 2013, is tasked, among others, to compile and maintain macroeconomic accounts and indicators, at the national and subnational level.

The Provincial Product Accounts (PPA) has been the mechanism of the PSA to compile the annual estimates of GDP by province and Highly Urbanized City (HUC), consistent with the National and Regional Accounts of the Philippines. In 2023, all provinces and HUCs of Western Visayas continue to implement the PPA since its inception in 2021, together with other regions. As of 2023, there are a total of 82 provinces and 33 HUCs compiling the PPA.
