## **Definition of Terms**

Consumer Price Index (CPI) - an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Inflation Rate - year-on-year changes in the CPI

**Purchasing Power of Peso** - measure of the real value of the peso in a given period relative to a chosen reference period. It is computed by getting the reciprocal of the CPI and multiplying the result by 100

Labor Force Participation Rate - proportion of total labor force to the total household population 15 years and over.

Employment Rate - proportion of employed persons to the total labor force.

Unemployment Rate - proportion of unemployed persons to the total labor force.

Underemployment Rate - proportion of underemployed persons to total employed persons

Literacy Rate - proportion of population who knows how to read and write simple messages.

Family Income - primary income and receipts from other sources received by all family members during the reference period, as participants in any economic activity or as recipients of transfers, pensions, grants, interests, food and non-food items received as gifts by the family

Family Expenditure - refer to the expenses or disbursements made by the family purely for personal consumption during the calendar year
